Action Research & Training for Health (ARTH), a 24 year old public health organization based in Udaipur (Rajasthan), has utilized community entrepreneurship platforms to improve access on part of young persons to contraception and other reproductive health services in a manner that respects choice and rights. After gaining experience by implementing the approach in its own field area, the organization seeks to explore and support scaling up of the same through other entities that work with women's groups, entrepreneurship platforms and social development interventions at community level.

We require an early to mid-career professional to anchor the process of representing key elements of the model and working with partners to explore ways to adapt and scale up the same in different contexts. A suitable candidate would be qualified have a professional background in social development, micro-finance or management, with at least 3 years experience in developing the capacity of marginalized persons, community collectives or micro-credit groups to adopt entrepreneurial activities and channel them for health or social change. A suitable candidate would be an energetic person with aptitude for communicating and working with groups and organizations, fluent in written and spoken Hindi and English, be able to analyze the influence of environmental factors and local context on community interventions, be tolerant of diverse viewpoints and able to help build consensus.
